Directions to The Owen County Extension Office

From Lexington & Frankfort Areas:

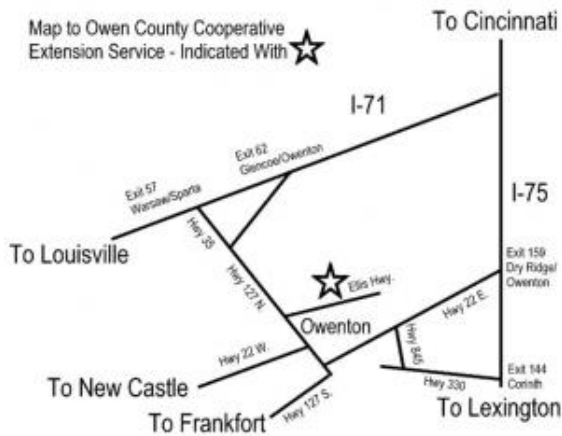
Take 127 N out of Frankfort for about 26 miles. Come through downtown Owenton. Just north of town, pass Owenton Cemetery. Turn right immediately past cemetery (green signs at end of road say Owen County Coop Extension). Drive about 1/4 mile and Extension Office is large brick building on the left just before the Owen County Fairgrounds.

From Louisville & Northern Kentucky:

Take I-71 to Sparta exit (Exit 57). Drive South about 15 miles (starts as Hwy 35, turns into Hwy 127 about 4 miles south of Sparta). Just as you are coming into Owenton, take a left just past a factory (Actaris) and just before the Owenton Cemetery (green signs at end of road say Owen County Coop Extension). Drive about 1/4 mile and Extension Office is large brick building on the left just before the Owen County Fairgrounds. (From Northern Ky., take Glencoe exit - Exit 62 - and follow 127 S into Owenton.)

From Scott and Grant County Areas:

Take I-75N from Georgetown. Take Corinth exit (Exit 144), turn left and follow Hwy 330 for about 10-12 miles. Go down a long hill through a little community (country store on left). Cross bridge over creek and immediately take very sharp (5-10 mph) right on Hwy 845. Drive about 3 miles (driving through Eden Shale Farm) and take left on Hwy 22. Drive about 5-7 miles into Owenton. Come through three stop lights into downtown Owenton (now on 127 N). Just north of town, pass Owenton Cemetery. Turn right immediately past cemetery (green signs at end of road say Owen County Coop Extension). Drive about 1/4 mile and Extension Office is large brick building on the left just before the Owen County Fairgrounds.
