Win With Wood Event

Thursday, October 13, 2011. The annual Win With Wood event was held at the University of Kentucky Wood Utilization Center in Quicksand, KY. The day started with wagons and dry weather; ended with hot and tasty wieners and wet winners.

One hundred and one students and forty three teachers, extension agents, KDF personnel, specialist, and Kentucky Forest Industries representatives made their way across the blue bridge on wagons, with straw bales for seats, to participate in the 2011 WWW. The rain held off most of the morning, but by lunch time a steady drizzle was coming down as Jim Spangler, Bryant Equipment Co. and Bob Bauer, Kentucky Forest Industries Association announced and handed out the awards for the 10 individual events that make up the entire Win With Wood program. The events are: Compass and Pacing, Forestry Equipment/Tools ID, Invasive Plant ID, Soil and Land Judging, Tree ID, Tree Measurement, Wood ID, Woodworking Tool ID. No individual points are awarded for these two events: Team Woodworking, and Individual Woodworking. The senior student with the highest overall score wins a \$500.00 scholarship to the College of Agriculture, University of Kentucky. The scholarship is endowed by the Kentucky Forest Industries Association and the University Of Kentucky College Of Agriculture.

The 2011 WWW scholarship winner is Jacob Gilliam, Carter County 4-H. Congratulations to Jacob and his 4-H agent Rebecca Konopka. The top 6 students, with the overall high points, included: 3 students from Carter County 4-H, 2 from McCreary County High and 1 from Lee County Middle School.
